Executive Board proposes Constitutional Amendments

The TMSCA Executive Board members met Dec. 12 and proposed the following Constitutional Amendments. Members will vote on them at the March and April general business meetings.

Constitutional Amendments

Article IV: Section 3A: (Current) The Board of Regents consists of twenty members, five from each UIL Region. Each region will be represented by one regent from each of the following designations: (1) 1A-3A, (2) 4A-5A, (3) high school, (4) middle school and (5) one at large.

(Proposed) The Board of Regents consists of twenty members, five from each UIL Region.. Each region will be represented by one regent from each of the following, **or equivalent UIL classification**, designations: (1) **1A-4A**, (2) **5A-6A**, (3) high school, (4) middle school and (5) one at large.

2013-2014 TMSCA Executive Board

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Executive Board meets Dec. 12

The TMSCA Executive Board meet in Dallas on December 13, 2014. The following items were discussed and actions taken (if needed) are included.

Executive Secretary's Report:

1. Trophy bids – Julie presented the bids for trophies for the state meets. There is a slight increase from last year's bid by Monarch Trophies. Monarch Trophies was awarded the bid for the state awards.
2. The Board voted to charge \$35 extra to cover copying and shipping charges if schools request hard copies of test pools or tournament tests instead of digital delivery.
3. The Board voted to approve the contracts from Bill Miller BBQ for meals at the state meets. The meal price will remain \$7.50, and we will again have the vegetarian meal option.

Treasurer's Report:

1. TMSCA has a balance of \$37,463.55 in the bank.
2. The Board voted to roll unclaimed scholarship money from the 2014 state meet back into the general operating fund, per TMSCA policy.
3. The Board reviewed the auditor's report. There were two exceptions that were noted and corrected. They approved the 2013-2014 auditor's report.

UIL Liaison Report: Possible calculator changes for the science test have been discussed by UIL. The main concern is the exclusion of graphing calculator usage on the test. The Board decided to do a survey of coaches at the high school state meet so that we can get feedback and opinions from TMSCA science coaches about these changes that can then be presented at the UIL Legislative Council Meeting in June.

High School Director's Report: The high school meet will be March 21, 2015, and we will open registration as soon as possible. A schedule for the meet will be posted on the TMSCA website.

Middle School Director's Report: The middle school meet will be on April 11, 2015. No awards ceremonies will begin until all the complete and final results have been printed by the tab room. The volunteers from UTSA will be conducting the awards ceremonies and taking all the pictures this year. The board also discussed the state law and the university requirement for abuse training for all volunteers. The Board approved a motion that all UTSA volunteers receive this training.

Middle School Qualifying Scores: The board discussed setting the qualifying scores the 2015 middle school champi-

Continued from page 1 regents will be elected by the voting membership in their respective regions in accordance with TMSCA classifications. Their term is two years. In odd-numbered years 1A-3A, high school and middle school regents are elected. In even-numbered years, 4A-5A and at large are elected.

(Proposed) The regents will be elected by the voting membership in their respective regions in accordance with TMSCA classifications. Their term is two years. In odd-numbered years 1A-4A (or equivalent UIL classification), high school and middle school regents are elected. In even-numbered years, 5A-6A (or equivalent UIL classification), and at large are elected.

Article V: Section 2: (Current) The state Meet will be held the weekend before the first week of the UIL literary district meet....

(Proposed) The State Meet will be held the weekend before the first week of the UIL academic district meet, if feasible....

Article V: Section 4B: (Current) All competition in these contest shall be by grade level and by school classification 1A-5A.

(Proposed) All competition in these contests shall be by grade level and by school classification 1A -6A or per current UIL classifications.

Article V: Section 4C: (Current) State Meet and Championship Meet awards will be presented for grade level individual, team, and sweepstakes champions. State meet and Championship Meet awards will be by conference.

(Proposed) State Meet and Championship Meet awards will be presented for grade level individual, team, and sweepstakes champions. State meet and Championship Meet awards will be by conference as per current (or equivalent) UIL classification. Classifications may be combined.

Out of State School Participation Following a request from a school from Las Vegas, Nevada, the Board voted to allow schools from out of state to join TMSCA

and participate in online meets only in the highest current UIL classification.

Clarification of middle school UIL classification: To clarify our current classification policy, the Board voted that if a middle school feeds into more than one high school with different classifications, then the middle school will be classified the same as the highest classification high school. This will be determined according to the official district feeder plan.

Newspaper/Newspaper editor: The Board voted to contract for four editions of the TMSCA newspaper to be completed by our current newspaper editor. These editions will be published in September, December/January, April and May. Any other news that needs to be reported during the year will be posted under the «News Blasts» tab on the TMSCA website.

PA Systems for State Meets: The

Board approved the purchase of two PA systems for the outdoor awards assemblies at the state meets.

Constitutional Amendments: The Board proposed amendments needed to bring the TMSCA Constitution into alignment with the new UIL classifications (specifically the addition of the 6A classification by UIL and TMSCA's combination of 1A & 2A classifications for awards purposes at the state meet). The Board also proposed to change the wording of the scheduling of the date of the high school state meet to read "if feasible" to give TMSCA flexibility to avoid possible future conflicts with other major events in the San Antonio area. These amendments will be published in the December/January newsletter. They will be voted on at the March and April General Business meetings by the general membership of TMSCA, as required in the Constitution.

Number Sense
 Number Sense involves a 10-minute, 80-question mental math test covering all high school mathematics courses. Shortcuts need to be developed and practiced in order to compete and finish the test.

Science
 This contest challenges students to do a wide range of reading in biology, chemistry and physics, to gain an understanding of the significance of experiments rather than to recall details, to be alert to new discoveries and information in the areas of science, to gain an understanding of the basic principles as well as knowledge of the history and philosophy of science, and to foster a sense of enthusiasm about how science affects our lives.

Calculator Applications
 This contest includes calculations involving addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, roots, powers, exponential, logarithms, trigonometric functions and inverse trigonometric functions. In addition to straightforward calculation problems, the contest includes geometric and stated problems similar to those found in algebra, geometry and trigonometry textbooks, previous contests and League materials related to the contest.

Mathematics
 This contest is designed to test knowledge and understanding in the areas of algebra I and algebra II, geometry, trigonometry, math analysis, analytic geometry, pre-calculus and elementary calculus.
